

RENTAL POLICIES

1. If an instrument is returned before the expiration of the initial 4.5 month trial period, no refunds will be given for the unused portion of the rent. At the end of the trial period, you may return the instrument with no further obligation, purchase it at a discounted rate, or continue renting at the monthly amount listed. All consecutive monthly payments after the initial trial may be applied towards purchase at the rate of \$35.00/per monthly payment for the bass; the trial period does not count towards purchase. Title of the rented instrument remains with THE VIOLIN DOCTOR, INC. until the full purchase price has been paid.
2. The insurance charge will cover damages due to theft, fire or flood up to the full value of the instrument. A police report detailing the theft or damage must be submitted at the time of the claim. **Your account must be current and in good standing in order for this coverage to apply. Insurance will NOT cover damages due to negligence, accidental damage or normal wear and tear.** The renter is financially responsible for the instrument regardless of where it is being kept (school grounds vs. home, etc.).
3. The credit card provided at the time of rental will be automatically charged on or about the 1st of each month when monthly payments become due. **Please note: We do not send monthly invoices or reminders at this time.** You are responsible for remitting payment on or before the due date established for your account. **If the credit card that you have provided is declined, cancelled or is changed without notification, this includes new expiration dates, your account will be assessed a late fee of \$8.00. If your card on file expires or is no longer valid, you are responsible for contacting us with the updated information for charges prior to your account's next due date.**
4. Provided your account is less than three months past due, the instrument may be returned at any time with all monies due. Accounts three months past due will be assigned to a professional collection agency or submitted to Small Claims Court. Those who permit their accounts to become that delinquent will **immediately become liable for the balance of the full purchase price** as well as for any additional costs incurred by The Violin Doctor, Inc. The return privilege will also be forfeited.
5. **RETURN PROCEDURE:** If you choose to return a rental instrument at any time to your school or music instructor, you must provide **written notice** (e-mail is acceptable) that the instrument is being returned. Please make sure the instrument and bow are in the case and make sure that the student's name is clearly marked on the blue case tag. If the tag has been lost, please use a replacement tag securely attached to the handle of the case and mark the student's name as well as The Violin Doctor on it. **Please include in your written notice the date of return, the student's name, the school and whether the instrument was left in the front office or with a teacher and the teacher's name. If these steps are not followed, your account may continue to be charged until such time as we can determine an instrument has been returned.** Once an instrument is returned, thereby terminating your rental account, any credit accrued toward a future purchase is lost and cannot be reinstated.
6. The approximate price range for student instruments, including the case (or cover), bow and rosin, is given below.
